ReEnergize Eagle County offers local working households a complimentary, comprehensive home energy assessment, energy coaching, and free home improvements. These measures aim to enhance the comfort, health, and energy efficiency of your home, which may lead to reduced utility bills. Participation in this program actively contributes to decreasing greenhouse gas emissions, instrumental to our community's climate action goals.

Local Working Households, and Retirees. Individual Unit/Home (any type). Owners or Renters. *See how to qualify at the bottom of this page.*

ENERGY VISIT & ENERGY COACHING

A complimentary, comprehensive home energy assessment includes a home visit (2-3 hours) & detailed report with recommended actions for home improvements. Energy coaching provided during & after home visit to ensure an understanding of energy use in the home and review projects that may be completed through ReEnergize.

FREE HOME IMPROVEMENTS

ReEnergize Eagle County will coordinate and pay for home improvements up to \$7,500 (annually).

Additional funds may be available from local utilities depending on each project & home location.

Household income must be at/below 150% AMI

(Area Median Income). *See chart to the right.*

Please provide estimated household annual income (all income earners in home; pre-tax), and one of the following for documentation:

- 3 most recent paystubs
- most recent Tax Return-IRS Form 1040* Wages
- Tax Statement W-2*
- Retirement Benefits Letter
- Letter from Employer
- Social Security Income (SSI)
- Social Security Disability Income (SSDI)
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)

Lower income households (at/below 80% AMI) will be connected to either WAP (Federal Weatherization Assistance Program) or CARE (Colorado's Affordable Residential Energy Program). ReEnergize Eagle County can help after a qualified household has completed WAP or CARE.
